In July we sent out a report that detailed the need for a new mission truck. The 10 year old Izuzu was just unreliable from its years of service. The cost for replacement was \$56,000. God had given me instruction to start saving a little each month for several years to put toward the replacement. That amount is \$20,000. We still needed to raise \$36,000. The conditions in Haiti with the gangs holding people captive, stealing their vehicles, and even killing those that resist, made the need for a reliable vehicle more urgent.



As you may already know, on July 7th, 2021 the President of Haiti, Jovnel Moise, was assassinated in his private residence. On August 15th the 7.2 earthquake occurred. These events put the country in shock and caused a cry for help. The compound was not damaged as our buildings are earthquake and hurricane safe. We are taking in families who are too scared to sleep in their homes.

We are currently distributing food supplies to those on the compound and families in our Bremen village. The Hebron Church is a "safe refuge" from the storms. It is a blessing to all those who attend. God has increased the congregation to 200+ people. Food is distributed discretely after the church service so that people do not become targets of those who would try and take the supplies.

Please join us in prayer for these brothers and sisters in our compound church and village. Pray for their faith to grow as they see Jesus providing for and protecting them. Pray that the mission continue to be blessed with the ability to supply these food needs. Pray for Haiti to return to Jesus and that His peace would replace the chaos. Let me just say that our school has grown by leaps and bounds this past year. The new school year will have doubled the student body. We will have close to 100 students in our school! That is so wonderful. These children are given a quality education and are enrolled in our nutrition program as part of their school day. I give a big, THANK YOU to the 6 teachers and to Headmaster, Luckner Mery for doing such a good job with the kids. We also thank the teacher aides and ladies who cook for the kids each day.

Education is such a big step

forward in Haiti. So many of the adults are illiterate and have not skills. The children in our school will have opportunities that their parents did not have. They will be able to read and write. They will be able to do math and understand basic science. We also hope to send in some refurbished computers to teach them basic computer skills and word processing. It is very exciting to see the positive progress for the school.

You are a major part of the school program Your sponsorship of a child each month gives us the ability to offer this education at no

cost to the student. It pays the salaries of the teachers, aides and administration. Your sponsorship gift pays for the food each day, school supplies, gas and oil for the bus and recreation supplies. Thank You so much. We currently have 45 students sponsored and need another 50 students sponsored at \$20/month. If you could help us find these new sponsors, we would be happy to give them all the details. Let me know if you would like to help distribute our Agape Academy Student Sponsor flyers and It will be sent to you right away. School starts in mid-September so we need the sponsors soon.



## **Agape Malnutrition Clinic News**

As you can imagine, the events of the last two weeks have really put families in deeper food insecurity. The earthquake and the Tropical Storm Grace have taken out bridges, damaged roads with large rocks and debris and washed away any crops that may have been planted.

Conditions like these make this clinic even more important. Our next clinic is August 28th. I just want to thank all of you who are helping with the funding of this clinic. It would not be possible without your help and prayers. Know that you are watching over 75 Malnourished babies and toddlers while they are in the program. We have already graduated 30 and replaced them with new patients on our waiting list. The impact is so amazing as we watch these struggling children regain their strength and become smiling, healthy little people. May God continue to bless this clinic
